Beach renourishment resumed

ST. PETE BEACH — The Pass-a-Grille beach-nourishment project resumed July 29, closing the area from Ninth Avenue to the fishing pier. Pass-a-Grille businesses will remain open and accessible throughout the project area, Pinellas County officials said in a press release. However, pier access and approximately 40 beach parking spaces on Gulf Way between First Avenue and Third Avenue will be closed for the duration of the project.

Portions of the beach not within the construction zone remain open, but beachgoers were advised to stay clear of active construction zones.

The southern section of the project is expected to be completed by mid-September, weather-permitting. At that time, the south end of the beach will be reopened and nourishment will be moved north of Paradise Grille. The entire project is scheduled to be finished by mid-November, again, weather-permitting.
